Brief description of the activity: The exposure trip comprised students of 3rd year BAMS accompanied by teaching faculty members. The First destination of the educational trip was Poison detection center, Department of forensic medicine and toxicology, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical college and Dr. Prabhakar Kore Hospital, Belagavi. The department museum houses a vast collection of specimens that showcase different cases of poisoning. It is an excellent opportunity for students to learn about various poisonous drugs, type of bullets, poisonous and non-poisonous snake specimens, visceral organs affected due to poisoning. The poison detection centre had toxicological analysis (qualitative) of blood, urine and stomach contents of living being. Thin layer chromatography technique was demonstrated to the students.
